- 4. Defendant's Rule 21(A)(3) Motion to Dismiss all claims in Plaintiff's Complaint is GRANTED.
- 5. Defendant's Rule 21(A)(5) Motion to Dismiss all claims in Plaintiff's Complaint is MOOT based upon the Court's ruling on Defendant's Rule 21(A)(3) Motion to Dismiss.
- 6. Plaintiff's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment is MOOT based upon the Court's ruling on Defendant's Rule 21(A)(3) Motion to Dismiss.
- 7. Plaintiff's Motion for Order striking Defendant's Motion to Classify Sharon Neal as a Vexation Litigant is DENIED.
- 8. Defendant's Motion to Classify Sharon Neal as a Vexation Litigant is GRANTED. Sharon Neal is declared a vexatious litigant and enjoined from filing further legal proceedings against Natalia Neal in Clackamas County Court without first obtaining the Presiding Judge's permission. The September 13, 2018 Order of Judge Kathie F. Steele in case number 18CV02117 is incorporated by reference as though set forth herein. Sharon Neal shall provide written notice to opposing counsel at least 48 hours or in the alternative hours before filing any motion or document in this case or in any case related to Defendant Natalia Neal. Violation of this order is subject to punishment for contempt of court. Any certificate of service filed by Sharon Neal must comply with this service order.
